MEMBERSHIP INFORMATION

The Association is registered as a company, with the prime objects of promoting and advancing the interests of British Citizens in, or connected with, Cyprus, as well as to promote and strengthen cultural ties and friendly relations between British and Cypriot citizens. The Registered Office of the Association is in the Clubhouse at Chlorakas.

Among the advantages of membership of the Association are the opportunities afforded to make contacts and friends amongst the British community, through an active and varied social programme, as well as the availability of informal advice on coping with the local official formalities and facilities such as tax, doctors and clinics, medical insurance etc. There is also a well-organised welfare service and the Association has an extensive free library service.

There are similar Associations in Limassol and Larnaca. Each Association has a Clubhouse with a range of social and other activities and visitors from other Associations are welcome (subject to numbers). Such Clubhouse events, activities and the overall running of the Clubhouses, including garden, are all done on a voluntary basis. Thus, it is essential that all members offer whatever help they can

Membership of the Association, as Ordinary Members, is open to British Citizens resident in, or connected with, the Republic of Cyprus who owe sole allegiance to the British Crown. For some people not meeting this full criterion, for example Dual Nationals, there is an Associate status. If in doubt, ask the Membership Secretary. There is also a Visitor Status for non-resident British Citizens. Application forms for Visitors are available from and will be processed by the Doorperson.

Please note that election to Membership will be taken as conclusive proof of assent to the Memorandum and Articles of Association and also to other Regulations, for the time being, of the Association, such as Clubhouse rules.

Our Association publishes a monthly Magazine for 10 months of the year which details the regular activities and social programme, as well as reporting on past events and including articles of general interest. The normal distribution of the Magazine is by collection from The Clubhouse after the 1st of the month, but where required the Magazine can be posted, on payment of postage costs, Inland = €10 and UK = €23 for a full year.

The Membership Secretary will process applications **only**:

- a. At the Club between 11.45 hrs and 13.45 hrs on Tuesdays and Fridays
- b. By appointment.

Please attend in person with your Passport, as it is necessary to confirm details & identity

Fees are:

(A) **Single/Individual Members** is €20 Joining Fee plus €35 membership = €55

(B) **Joint Membership for Couples** is €40 Joining Fee plus €70 membership = €110

You can Pay Either with a Cyprus Bank Cheque or with Cash (*Please Note: The currency of the Island is Euros*)

NOTES TO AID COMPLETION OF THE MEMBERSHIP APPLICATION

1. The form is appropriate for two people living at the same address, whether or not they have the same surname. Note that the database entry will be indexed on the details of the First Applicant, so make sure the order is as you want it to appear on address labels etc. If there are special reasons why two co-resident applicants wish to be registered separately, this can be accommodated.
2. **Before writing anything**, please read through the form so you know what information is required and the sequence in which it is to be entered. If you are in doubt about any entry, leave it blank until you see the Membership Secretary to join.
3. In "Familiar Name" enter the forename or nickname by which you are known to your friends.
4. We give space for both "Postal Address" and "Residential Address" because many Members use Post Office boxes or similar agencies. Please make sure you maintain the differentiation, do not mix PO Box with residential address. If you receive your post at home the second column should be left blank.
5. *We give space for your "e-mail address" as the Club now contacts as many of its members as possible by monthly e-mail shots with current information and Club news. Please write clearly your e-mail address.*
6. Obviously, the majority of applicants will hold only a British Passport. For most of these the "Issue Authority" will be "UKPA". For others the detail will normally be found at the bottom right hand corner of the data page. Where an applicant holds a British and a second passport it is the details of the former that should be entered.
7. The Association has, in the past, experienced difficulty should Members become incapacitated (eg traffic accident). This is the reason we ask for a contact address and phone number. What is needed is a contact who is sufficiently informed of your affairs to be able to initiate action in such a case and who is unlikely to be incapacitated at the same time. A Family member or someone whom you trust to be contacted in an emergency.
8. Please remember the declarations on the reverse of the form. Again the majority will owe sole allegiance and should sign Declaration 1 on the first page of application. Other classes need to sign the Declaration appropriate to their status. If in doubt, wait and ask.
